

Carver Middle School Expectations and Policies Regarding: Tardies, Uniform, and Cell Phones/Electronic Devices

Tardy Policy

All students should be on campus no later than the first bell, which rings at 8:20 a.m. Students are to be in their first class of the day, seated, quiet, and ready to work before the tardy bell rings at 8:30 a.m. Students arriving after 8:30 a.m. should report to the office for a pass to class. All students should be on time to all classes.

1st Tardy: Warning

2nd Tardy: Warning

3rd Tardy: Call Home

4th Tardy: Parent Called, After School Detention assigned

5th Tardy: Parent Called, After School Detention assigned

Excessive Tardies: Discipline Referral-ISI assigned

Uniform Policy

All students should be properly dressed in school uniform items. Students should be properly dressed upon entering the building and maintain the uniform look for the entire day.

1st Infraction: Student reports to office for infraction to be logged in

2nd Infraction: Student reports to office for infraction to be logged in

3rd Infraction: Student reports to office for infraction to be logged in, parent called

4th Infraction: Student reports to office for infraction to be logged in, parent called, After School Detention assigned.

5th Infraction: Student reports to office for infraction to be logged in, parent called, After School Detention assigned

Excessive Infractions: Discipline Referral-ISI assigned

Cell Phones/Electronic Devices Policy

Cell phones and electronic devices (cameras, Ipods, video games, MP3 players, etc.) **MUST** be turned off upon entrance into the building and locked in lockers during school hours. Ringing phones and text messaging have been the cause of disturbances in classrooms. Cell phones and electronic devices will be confiscated when seen or heard **during school hours**. **Parents will be required to pick up the phone (it will not be returned to the student)** and a consequence will be assigned. **THE SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN MP3 PLAYERS, CELL PHONES, GAME DEVICES, ETC.**

1st Confiscation: Warning, device returned to parent

2nd Confiscation: Assigned one day after school detention, returned to parent

3rd Confiscation: Assigned two days after school detention, sent to TPS Campus Police

4th Confiscation: Discipline referral, assigned ISI, sent to TPS Campus Police

Excessive Confiscations may result in out-of-school suspension
