Dear Carver Supporter:

The state of Oklahoma leads the nation with its cuts to school funding (an average decrease in spending of 24% per student), our classroom sizes have increased an average of 26%, and \$40 million has been eliminated from our state's activities budget. We are the Carver Family fighting for our Tulsa Public middle school students and we need your help.

Carver Middle School PTSA is a 501(c)(3) and is dedicated to not only funding the unmet critical & forecasted needs of our children and our faculty but also providing additional curriculum enhancement opportunities within the confines of the classroom.

Our annual fundraiser, Jazz and Jeans will raise funds to assist teachers throughout the middle school with wish lists, unsupported needs from state funding, and updating equipment as necessary. Some of the items that we hope to be able to tackle as a result of this added income are:

- Address safety concerns and upgrades of current monitoring equipment
- Enhanced field trip experiences (supplementing the scholarship fund for students who are unable to afford costs of travel trips)
- Resources to conduct extra-curricular activities with minimized costs to teacher/parents
- Teacher support fund which allows each teacher to apply to fund for additional supplies (at no cost to them) to improve the quality of teaching lesson – and make for more positive outcomes

Traditional state and local funding has failed to adequately provide for the educational needs of our children. If you are a citizen of this community who would like to partner in meeting the needs of our students, or a business that would like to invest in the future of our Tulsa, your donation item or funds to offset the fixed costs of this event would ultimately impact the resources that are placed in the hands of our children and our faculty.

We greatly appreciate your consideration to donate at any level you are able. They are our future.
